# Action Taken Report of IQAC meeting held on 13/06/2020

The decisions executed by IQAC based on the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> June is as follows Action taken:

- 1. Reviewed last meeting
- 2. Due to pandemic situation and government guideline online classes has taken for students on line. Prior to the schedule of the university, classes started from June 22<sup>nd</sup> onwards. All components like capacity improvement programme, NET/SET, MPSC, UPSC, remedial classes have been included in the time table. Parents meeting were held to give details about online classes
- 3. April 2020 onwards Covid response activities have been initiated by the institute. During the first wave of Covid pandemic when the lockdown was imposed we realised the urgent need of dry ration kits to be provided to the affected families due to lockdown. In collaboration with our ex-students, our staff members and well-wishers provided dry ration kits to around 100 families. Later on with help of companies under CSR fund after assessing the ground level reality distributed ration kits in four blocks of Satara districts namely, Satara ,Wai, Jaoli and Mahableshwar. We had taken support from the local organisations working in these respective areas. Most of the organisations which are supported us in this response activities were having our alumni as their employees. Also in this whole process we were closely connected with the district administration and with their authorities we had gone for jointly executing each and every activity.

This Covid response resulted in raising a fund of approximately 50 akh rupees through which we had initiated the activities,

4. Continuous evaluation has taken place in online mode. Teachers and students were given training for the same. Some of the faculty attended faculty development programme conducted by Ramanujan College regarding online teaching and learning. This self learning initiative made the online teaching and learning process and evaluation quality based. Management subscribed ZOOM for conducting webinars and classes. Teachers used own Zoom also. The

- technical knowledge shared to one another. A few teachers trained Ashram school teachers to enable them for online teaching.
- 5. New collaboration with Tech Mahindra Foundation, Pune, Karuna Trust, UK, Jansahas, Madhya Pradesh, Save The Children, Mumbai, Persistent Foundation, Pune, Atlas Copco, Pune, Cipla Foundation, Pune initiated for Covid response as well as community development activities.
- 6. As physical Field work is not possible it was decided to conduct Virtual visits to various eminent organisation. Class wise virtual visits were arranged by faculty. MPSW students were placed for field work in civil hospital.
- 7. Admission process of MSW and BSW have been done online. Students were given orientation prior to entrance and conducted the process effectively. Induction programme organised for MSW and BSW Part 1 students.
- 8. Nine national level webinars were conducted on different topics and the response of webinars were good. Topics include NAAC accreditation, women empowerment, parenting, community engagement etc.

- 2. Covid response activities include infrastructural development of PHCs Wai Rural Hospital, Wai: 5 ICU semi fowler beds, Testing Lab equipment's, WASH facility & Biomedical Waste Management System. Sponsored by Persistent Foundation, Pune Total cost around 15,00,000.00Rs.

Medha Rural Hospital, Medha: 12 ICU semi fowler beds, 12 Multipara Monitors, Central Monitoring System, 2 Philips Ventilators, 12 Side Tables. Sponsored by Save the Children, Mumbai & Tech Mahindra Foundation, Pune – Total cost around 25,20,340.00 ChildrensCovid Care Centre, Bachat Gat Bhavan, Medha: 20 semi fowler beds. Sponsored by Tech Mahindra Foundation, Pune – Total cost around 3,00,000.00Rs.

Covid Care Centre, Raigaon: 5 Portable Oxygen Concentrators. Sponsored by Tech Mahindra Foundation, Pune – Total cost around 2,50,000.00Rs. - 7. Admission process 2021-22 has taken place online
- 8. Online webinars have been conducted on research and other cotemporary issues.4 faulty completed refresher course
- 9. NAAC accreditation preparation have been started and responsibilities have been assigned to teaching and nonteaching staff.
- 10. It is decided to form an internal BOS to look in to syllabus. From coming academic year certificate and diploma courses will be started to enhance the employability skills of the students. Discussions were held with employers and alumni
